SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

The following requirements are adhered to by our Staff during events being held with attendance by members of the public:

- 1 We complete a risk assessment before the event.
- 2 We will review the risk assessment once we are on site and make any amendments as required.
- 3 Trailer skirts, bins, boxes and other trip hazards will be kept neatly stowed subject to any constraints and operational practices at the site.
- 4 LPG cylinders are used on the trailer and are securely housed on the vehicle.
- 5 We will familiarise ourselves with any emergency procedures at the event.
- 6 No alcohol shall be consumed or drugs taken (other than as may be prescribed by a medical practitioner) whilst manning our stall. There is a no smoking policy at and around the stall.
- 7 If electrical equipment is used, this will be supplied by our own generator which is rated at 7KVA 32Amp unless there is a suitably rated supply on the site. The generator will be located in a suitable and safe location subject to site conditions and operational practices. Equipment used will have been subject to portable electrical inspection testing where appropriate.
- 8 The site area will be kept tidy at all times and waste and surplus materials shall be removed from the site as appropriate and in accordance with site procedures.
- 9 We do not use or have any chemicals or harmful substances.
- 10 The securing and use of the mobile catering trailer will be carried out within the provisions of any relevant instructions, policy statements or guidance notes issued or in practice by either the company or the event organisers.
- 11 Waste water will be contained within our waste feed directly into a waste water container and then will be emptied as required subject to complying with the provisions of any relevant instructions, policy statements or guidance notes issued or in practice by either the company or the event organisers.
- 12 Catering equipment used in the trailer is checked for correct operation before each event. A fire extinguisher and fire blanket is carried on the vehicle during an event. Fire fighting equipment will be properly maintained according to current recommendations and guidelines. Fire fighting equipment will have a designated location which will be communicated to our staff on site.
- 13 A first aid kit will be kept and maintained on the vehicle at all times.
